# JAMBOREE GLOSSARY TERMS

The following are the common ones used at Jamboree.

- **CONTINGENT** - The term "contingent" has now been replaced with "Jamboree Troop".
- **JAMBOREE TROOP** - The name for a Troop formed to attend the Jamboree. A Troop is a maximum of 36 Scouts and seven Leaders going to the Jamboree.
- **JAMBOREE TROOP LEADER** - The Troop Leader is responsible for leading the Jamboree Troop.
- **LEADER IN A TROOP** - The term describes a Leader with a Jamboree Troop who is not the Jamboree Troop Leader.
- **JAMBOREE LEADERSHIP TEAM (JLT)** - Is the Jamboree Executive Team and ensures the approved objectives of the Jamboree. They are responsible for the overall organisation of the Jamboree. There are eight Directorates.
- **JAMBOREE MANAGEMENT TEAM (JMT)** - Responsible for managing different areas of the Jamboree within the eight Directorates. It comprises members leading several teams and may include other Deputy Managers and Team Leaders.
- **JAMBOREE RELATIONS TEAM (JRT)** - Responsible for marketing communications, relations acquisitions, international support, and support of a Scout to the Jamboree.

- **JAMBOREE SUPPORT TEAM (JST)** - A team of Venturers, supported by Leaders, assists at the Jamboree in helping at activity bases and in some administrative functions. The JST replaces what the Venturer Service Team referred to at the last Jamboree.
- **JAMBOREE YOUTH LEADERSHIP TEAM (JYLT)** - This team provides counsel pre and during the Jamboree as the principal focus of Scouts Aotearoa's rangahti/young people at the centre. This group is aged 11 to 15, and two young leaders lead the team replacing the Jamboree Patrol referred to at the last Jamboree.
- **JAMBOREE STAFF** - Adults who are volunteers who help run or assist in an area, function or activity at the Jamboree.
- **JAMBOREE TROOP SITE** - The area assigned for a Jamboree Troop. Normally approx. 700 sqm, where the Jamboree Troop sleeps, does laundry, relaxes, meets, cooks and eats together.
- **THE HUB** - Responsible for registrations, the Jamboree shop, operations/service and information centre.
- **OLEMS** - The online registration system - Online Event Management System.
