### STAFF CAMP TEAM

#### STAFF CAMP MANAGER

Staff Required – 1

Reporting to the Camp Support Director and Assistant Camp Support Director, this role will see you undertake the following tasks:

- Recruit other Adult Leaders to provide a welcoming, relaxed Staff Camp area. Ideally, these staff will have a camping, backpacking or similar background.
- Monitoring of the Staff Camp atmosphere and vibe.
- Develop an equipment list for the staff camp and an overall budget for the Staff Camp area in conjunction with the Camp Support Director.
- Ensure good two-way communication between Camp Support Director, Welfare staff and Troop Support staff.
- Contribute to the overall Camp Support team, including budgeting and timeframes, communications, and a post-Jamboree evaluation.
- Communicate with staff before Jamboree and determine their needs (i.e. power for medical equipment or fridge access for medicines etc.)
- Develop a Staff Camp layout. (Camping sites and communal staff area).
- Help pair up staff with other staff to share tents with.
- Be able to arrive at Jamboree before other staff and help set up the Staff Camp area (approx 27th or 28th December).
- Distributing tents and camping equipment to internationals and retrieving them at the end of Jamboree.
- Come up with ideas and run Staff Camp activities evenings, i.e. Bingo night.

## STAFF CAMP TEAM

Staff Required – 3

Reporting to the Staff Camp Manager, this role will see you undertake the following tasks:

- Be able to arrive at Jamboree before other staff and help set up the Staff Camp area (approx 27th or 28th December).
- Help show arriving staff to their campsite and record which site they are in on the Staff Camp map.
- Help with internationals in erecting tents/stretchers etc.
- Maintain a clean site by monitoring the cleanliness of the site areas, i.e., toilet/shower area.
- Help other staff if they need help in the washing area.
- Do regular walks around the site to ensure no unauthorised people in the Staff Camp area, close up tents if it starts raining etc.
- Help keep the staff communal area clean and tidy.
- Communicate with the Staff Camp Manager on any issues.
- Help run Staff Camp activities evenings.
